1. The Monaco America website address is www.MonacoAmerica.com. The "www" is not required and upper and lower case does not matter. You can use monacoamerica.com to reach the website.
2. The website is organized into three major parts -- the Website, the Forum, and the Photo Album. Links to the forum and photo album are on the main website at www.MonacoAmerica.com.
3. **WEBSITE.** There is a navigation bar at the top of each page of the website. Some of the entries on the bar have drop down menus.

This is the Home Page:



The tabs on the navigation bar are Home, Rally, Club Leadership, Newsletters, Forum, Membership, Photos, Stories, and Contact. A description of each page is given below.

The Contact page has a fill-in-the-blank form you can use to contact the club leadership or webmaster.

4. You will need to have Adobe Reader installed to read some pages such as the membership roster. Adobe Reader is a free download program available at www.adobe.com/products/reader/.

5. The membership roster and membership directory are password protected because they contain personal information about club members. The username and password can be obtained from the Webmaster. Use the Contact form to request the username and password, or send an email to webmaster@monacoamerica.com with your request. Only club members can access the membership roster and membership directory. The username and password are case sensitive, so type them in all lower case letters. The log-in information applies to all members of the club and should not be shared with anyone who is not a club member.

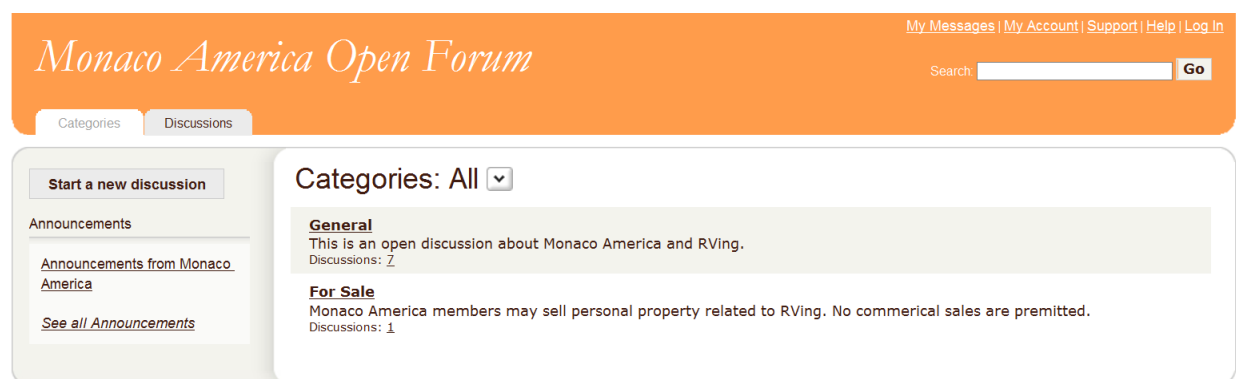
The membership roster is a listing of all club members with their contact information. It can be read on screen, saved or printed.

The membership directory is a series of web pages similar to a book with one page for each club member. There is an alphabetical directory that allows you to turn directly to a member's page. You turn the pages of the directory using the arrow buttons on each page. Club members may add any personal information to their page by sending an email to webmaster@monacoamerica.com. You may add a personal story and photos to your page. If your personal page is not included in the membership directory, contact the webmaster to have one built for you. The membership directory is under construction.

6. **FORUM.** The forum is a place where members can read announcements, post comments, and ask questions. You reach the forum from the Forum tab on the navigation bar of any website page. Anyone can read the forum, but you must register a user name and password to post comments.

The log-in button is in the upper right of the forum main page. You choose your log-in user name and password yourself. When you first try to log-in, you will be asked to register. Follow the on-screen instructions. When your registration is approved, you will be notified by e-mail. Your forum password is case sensitive. Remember, your password to the Forum is known only to you so keep it in a safe place. The webmaster cannot recover a lost password.

This is the Forum main page:



Members can create new discussion topics or join in current discussions by posting comments.

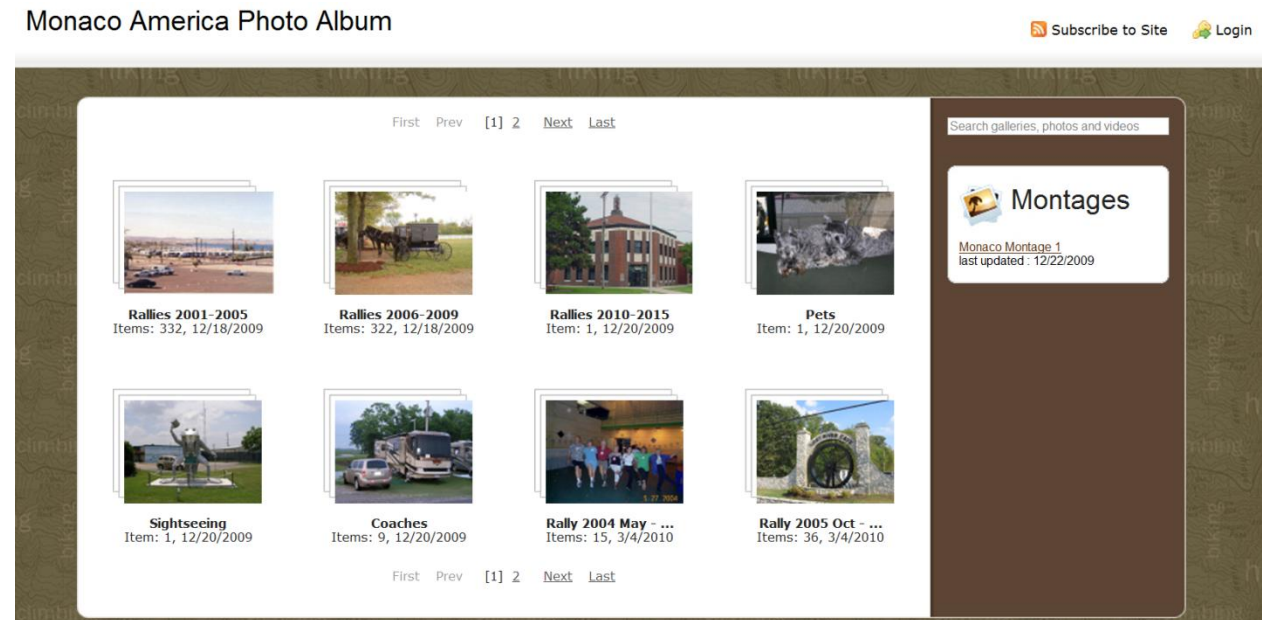
There is a separate Category for For Sale ads. You may post For Sale ads for RV-related items on the forum.

7. **PHOTO ALBUM.** Open the photo album from the Photos tab on the navigation bar. The photo album is organized into galleries which are collections of photos with a common theme such as rallies, pets, or coaches. Click on a gallery to view thumbnails of the photo collection. Click on any photo thumbnail to enlarge it. When the photo is enlarged, you will see left and right arrows that allow you to page through the gallery. Also, if you click on the slideshow tab, a slideshow will automatically run to display all the photos in a gallery. If you want to download a photo to your computer, click on the download link under each thumbnail photo.

Members are encouraged to submit photos for the photo album. A small number of photos can be emailed to the webmaster. If you have a large number of photos, you can mail a CD disk to the

webmaster. Contact the webmaster by email at webmaster@monacoamerica.com for mailing instructions.
